

Thanks for choosing Uniquely Inviting for your wedding programs. Use this worksheet to help gather all of the information that you'll need to order them. Programs can include as little or as much information as you want. Most times they include a rundown of the ceremony and a listing of the wedding party and people involved with the wedding. They can also include a thank you note to your guests, a note about memory candles or flowers, favorite quotes or scripture verses, photos or just about anything else that you'd like to include.

Our most popular formats are standard folded programs (either 5.5" x 8.5" or 4.25" x 11") and flat 4.25" x 11" programs. Other shapes and folds (square, z-fold, etc.) are available upon request. The format you choose depends on personal preference and how much information you'd like to include.

Since ceremonies can vary depending on whether it is a civil or religious ceremony, just the wedding or a full church service and the needs of any given couple, there is not really a "standard" ceremony. Generally, most couples will meet with their officiant, musicians and other involved parties about a month before the wedding to finalize the order of the ceremony, readings, songs, etc. Most officiants will provide you with a copy of the ceremony info and this is a great place to start.

The Ceremony

As previously mentioned, there isn't really a standard ceremony outline. It can vary based on whether it is a or civil or religious ceremony (with or without a full church service) and the personal preferences of the couple. In the majority of cases, your officiant can provide you with an exact outline of the ceremony they will be performing. How much of that information you want to include in the program is up to you. Some couples choose just a basic outline, some mention readings and names of readers, songs, etc. Some things that you may want to include are:

• Prelude:
• Lighting of Candles
• Lighting of Unity Candles by the Mothers
Seating of the Families -OR- Seating of the Grandparents
• Seating of the Mothers (mother of groom is seated first, mother of bride is seated last)
• The Groom's Entrance
